STATE OF MIND STATIONS

Beginning in November, NPR will install its first set of State of Mind Stations in the immediate neighborhood surrounding Southern Exposure. The stations are small kiosk displays mounted in public places such lampposts, street signs, and buildings. Neighbors, visitors, commuters, and passers-by can transmit their feelings, thoughts, concerns, and desires from any State of Mind Station. The collected messages are aired every Friday night from 9 to 11 pm and will also be available as podcasts downloadable from [www.neighborhoodpublicradio.org](http://www.neighborhoodpublicradio.org) and streamed over the web.
