**San Francisco, CA, August 31, 2010** – Southern Exposure is proud to host **Art Publishing Now (APN)**, a two-day event dedicated to the investigation and showcasing of art publishing practices in the Bay Area. **Art Publishing Now** includes a summit of presentations and critical discussions, an after-party, an art publishers fair, and a library and archive. APN takes place from Saturday October 9, 2010 starting at 11:00 am, through Sunday, October 10, 2010 until 6:00 pm. All events take place at Southern Exposure, 3030 20<sup>th</sup> Street in San Francisco and are FREE and open to the public.

**Art Publishing Now** seeks to gather leading local groups from the burgeoning, independent Bay Area arts publishing community realizing projects ranging from online periodicals, blogs, critical writing and essays, magazines, books, periodicals, podcasts, open source databases, arts editions, and newer hybrids forms. The two-day event is inclusive of the myriad variations of art publishing.

The event also aims to serve as a conduit to bring this robust community together, give them a public forum to share their work with each other and the public, and create a new sense of agency among them. Likewise, as SoEx has become a funder and supporter of independent publishing projects through its *Alternative Exposure* grant program, SoEx is excited to shed light on the wealth of innovative projects. **Art Publishing Now** is organized by Southern Exposure and a 13 person Advisory Group of Bay Area publishers.

## **ART PUBLISHING NOW SUMMIT**

The 2010 Art Publishing Now Summit invites the public to join leading creators of print, online, and experimental publications to reflect on the most urgent issues and exciting possibilities in art publishing today. With topics ranging from “Publish AND Perish” to “West Coast Critical?”, the event will include a series of presentations, conversations, and panels intended to yield insight and encourage innovation in Bay Area art publishing. The event is free and open to the public.
