Unlike many open calls that charge a submission fee, Southern Exposure's juried exhibition is entry-fee free. *Me and You and This Other Thing* features 50 Northern California artists living north of King City and south of Red Bluff. Over the course of two days, artists brought their artwork and proposals for installation, performance, social practice, site-specific and web-based work to Southern Exposure. For many of the artists selected, this is their first major exhibition and a vital step forward in their art careers.
